

## ICERP 2006 REPORT

International Conference and Exhibition on Reinforced Plastics 2006, the third event in the ICERP series was held at Chennai Trade Centre, Chennai during Feb.23-25.2006.

### Inaugural Function

## **Conference programme**

The two day conference programme started on 24 the Feb,2006 with the business session which was followed by 7 technical sessions. The second day of the conference started with thermosets and processing followed by thermoplastic composites and composites in Energy sector.

There were totally 13 invited lectures and 21 contributed papers presented during the two day conference programme.
